



Maintain Social Distance

- 2m from Adults
- The best practical distance at all times
- Limit contact outside of class groupings



Wash Your Hands

- Before you leave home
- When you arrive at school
- Before you eat
- After visiting the toilet
- Use Hand Sanitiser (but not a substitute for washing your hands)



Catch it, Bin it, Kill it

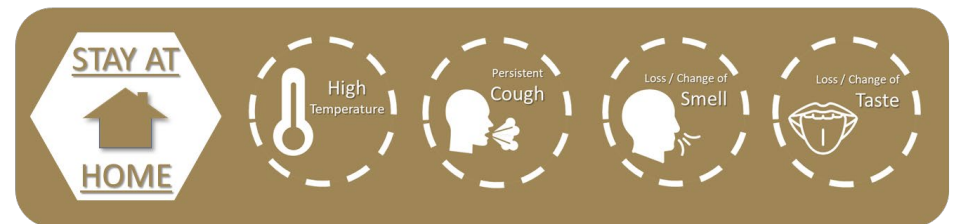
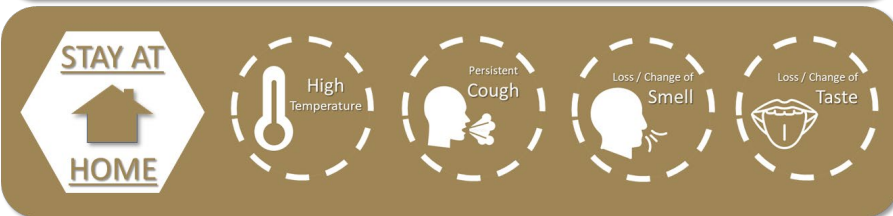
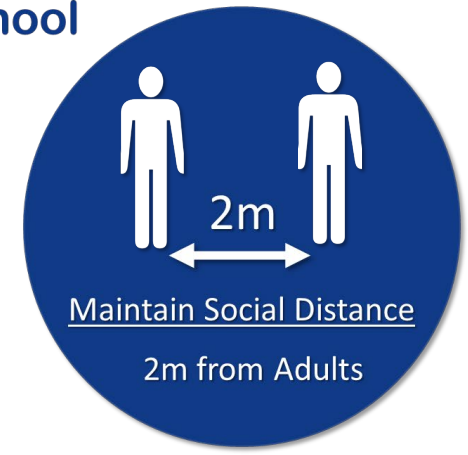
- Sneeze/Cough into a tissue
- Immediately put into bin
- If you have no tissue – sneeze/cough into your elbow not your hand.
- Wash/sanitise hands immediately



Wear your Mask

- Wear your mask at all times indoors and on buses
- Avoid touching your face, mouth & eyes

5 Steps to a Safer School for everyone



Stay at Home and Do Not Come into School if...

You or any member of your household has symptoms of Covid:

- Stay at Home
- Get tested for Covid-19
- Share the results of your test with the school

Social Distancing

One of the most important ways of reducing transmission is to stay apart as far as possible

- Stay at a 2m distance from adults
- Stay at the safest possible distance from other students
- Remain in your class and year groups to reduce contact

Health and Hygiene

- Wear a mask at all times on buses and when anywhere inside the school building
- Avoid touching your face (eyes, mouth and nose)
- Wash your hands regularly and use hand sanitiser regularly in between
- Bring a pocket sanitiser to school each day
- Ensure high respiratory hygiene (catch-it, bin-it, kill-it)

Uniform and Resources

- Wear a clean uniform each day – including a washed mask
- You may wear your full PE uniform only on the day you have PE
- Your school bag should be cleaned and sanitized regularly
- Bring your own water as the water fountains are not available
- Only use the toilet designated for your group and observe the number limit

Arrival at School

- If the weather is good, stay in your designated Year Group outside space
- Proceed directly to your Tutor Room and do not wait in the corridors or congregate in any indoor area

In the Classroom

- You will have all your classes in your tutor room or classroom
- You will remain in the same seat each day
- You must immediately take your seat upon arrival and not wait or congregate in the corridors
- You are responsible for sanitising your own seat and table with the spray provided
- Bring your own equipment as sharing will not be permitted

Around the School

- Each year group is situated in a 'designated zone'
- If you are moving to a classroom, you can use the quickest route within your Year Group 'designated zone'
- At ALL other times you must follow the one-way system including stairwells which are now 'one-way'
- During a fire evacuation you exit by the nearest exit (**do not follow the one-way system**)
- Do not wait or congregate in corridors / inside the school building

Break and Lunch

- You will have 'break' in your period 2 classroom or in your designated Year Group 'outside space'
- The Canteen is strictly only available to Sixth Form at breaktime**
- You will have lunch in your 'lunch centre' and then move to your designated 'outside space' (weather permitting)
