

School Uniform Policy Pupils in Years 8 to 12 (June 2022)

I thank you for your support in helping the school to implement our Uniform Policy.

Just as we are proud of our pupils I would hope, too, that they take a pride in their uniform and always remember that when they wear it, they are representing Rathmore and the entire school community.

Please ensure, too, that all items of uniform are clearly marked with your child's name and class.

All stockists have been advised on appropriate uniform and pupils will be asked to replace item(s) that do not meet these regulations.

*These items are not compulsory

From September 2022 girls may choose to wear straight-legged, black school trousers and black socks. These trousers can be purchased from our suppliers; the style is Banner–Contemporary and can be viewed on the school website. Parents are of course free to source trousers of the same style from the school clothing section of any high street retailer where available.

Hair: should be clean and tidy and of a natural colour and acceptable style.

Jewellery: A watch, a small ring and a pair of small stud earrings, one in each ear lobe, are the only items of jewellery that may be worn in school.

Make-up: make-up should not be worn in Years 8–10; a light foundation cream is permitted for Years 11 & 12.

Nail varnish / gels / acrylics / fake tan should not be worn.

Boys should be clean shaven.
