Upper and Lower Six

On returning to Rathmore as a Sixth Form pupil you must take pride in your personal appearance and remember that when you wear the Sixth Form uniform you are representing the school. As a **Sixth Form pupil**, we will be relying on you to set a **good example** to the rest of the school by wearing **only** what is on the uniform list.

Girls' Hair: must be clean, tidy and of a natural colour and style.

Boys' Hair: must be clean, tidy and of a natural colour and style. Cuts shorter than No. 2 are not permitted. Boys must be clean shaven.

Jewellery: The only jewellery permitted is a watch, a small ring and a pair of small stud earrings, one in each ear lobe.

Make-up: A **light** foundation cream permitted.

Nail varnish/gels/acrylics/fake tan are not permitted.
